RECEPTION TRANSITION TO YEAR 1

From Monday 24th April, in readiness for moving to Year 1, children in Reception will enter school via the main cloakroom from the yard (where Years 1 and 2 enter) instead of through their classroom door. Reception children should initially

enter at 8:30am please (and will be greeted by Mrs Armstrong) and **Years 1 and 2 can enter after Reception at 8:35am**. Please could we ask children in Years 1 and 2 to stand back to allow Reception to enter first whilst they are getting used to their new routine. 


