This pack contains:

- Home learning challenges to embed phase 2 and phase 3 phonic sounds.
- The next White Rose Hub maths units on capacity, 3D shapes and spatial awareness. These units give brief guidance of what is expected of children as well as some suggested activities to develop children's understanding.
- Purple Mash log in details and a simple guide of how to support your child to use the website.
- Suggested activities to support children's learning towards the Early Learning Goals.
- A range of activities to support your child's number knowledge.

As well as this pack of activities to try at home, it is important that your child continues to read their reading books regularly. Children also have their phonic sound packs in their book bags. Please continue to use these, thank you. The phonics play website (<https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/>) and the app, 'Teach your Monster to Read' are also great ways to practice your child's phonics.
