SCHOOL DINNER DEBTS

As you are already aware, I asked all parents and carers to clear any debts on ParentMail, before half term, so that we could transfer to a new system for managing school lunches in school. Individual letters have now been sent out to parents and carers whose accounts we believe are not up to date. If you think the amount is incorrect, please let Mrs Pygall know and she will seek to resolve the issue. Unfortunately, those parents whose debts were not cleared have had to be referred to the LA debt management system, as we are unable to continue to sustain lunch debts as a school.

Although most of the amounts are individually relatively small, I am sure you will understand that cumulatively this creates a large deficit for the school with impacts the budget and therefore the children's education. There is a small number of very large debts; in this case you may be offered a repayment plan via the LA. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

ParentMail is updated every Friday to show school lunches taken for the week so ParentMail account balances should, going forward, always be up to date on a Friday afternoon. ParentMail should send users a reminder, each week, of money owed therefore I do not intend to write each half term to tell parents and carers how much is due for lunches. If you do not receive ParentMail reminders, or are struggling to use ParentMail, Mrs Pygall would be happy to help you. Lunches are £2.00 per day for children in Years 3 &4 (therefore £10 per week) and £1.90 for children in Nursery (weekly amounts depend on your child's attendance pattern). In future, Mrs Pygall will also write to parents who are in arrears of 2 weeks, before debts become unmanageable. I hope this clarifies the current system.

OPERATION ENCOMPASS

OPERATION ENDEAVOUR

This week, we have received information from the Local Authority about Operation Endeavour. Operation Endeavour is a safeguarding arrangement between Newcastle Children's Social Care Service, Northumbria Police and schools and colleges in Newcastle to safeguard children and young people at



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risk of harm from going missing. Following any report of a child going missing to the Police, the Police will contact Children's Social Care who will then communicate relevant and necessary information to the children's school.

It follows a very similar process as Operation Encompass (in which information is sent to schools following police being called to domestic abuse incidents). There is a poster attached to this newsletter for your information.

NATIVITY TICKETS UPDATE


As you are aware, Nativity ticket bookings went live last week. This year we increased the tickets, per family, to **3 tickets per Key Stage performance** (each Key Stage will perform the same play twice) to allow children to perform to a wider audience, whilst still remaining within the school fire restriction numbers.

As many of our parents work, we offer an evening performance to allow them an opportunity to see their children perform. The evening performance is always really busy with parents who work during the day. If you are able to come to the afternoon performance(s) rather than the evening we would be grateful if you did so, leaving evening tickets available to those who are unable to come during the day. Thank you for your help with this matter!

Unfortunately, many families have booked 3 tickets per performance or per child (rather than 3 in total) which meant the evening performance 'sold out' very quickly. Mrs Pygall has therefore contacted these people to remove some of their tickets. We are, unfortunately, going to have to be very strict on ticket numbers to ensure we remain within fire regulations. We would be grateful if you only took the number you need (max of 3) so that other families do not miss out. If you do not need all three tickets please let Mrs Pygall know as she has a waiting list of people still wanting tickets. Please can we ask that parents DO NOT swap tickets amongst themselves as Mrs Pygall's ticket list will be the criteria which is used to admit parents to each performance and ensure we have a correct list of people on site.

If you would like additional tickets, please contact Mrs Pygall who will add your name to the waiting list, once all families have been allocated their ticket(s).

Please note, our children who are performing are still very young and easily distracted/put off by noise in the audience, therefore we would be grateful if our



audience was adults/older siblings only, if possible. Siblings in school will already have seen each of the nativities, during school time. Thank you.

We do not charge for tickets to school Nativities however school has to pay a license fee for each performance and we would therefore welcome voluntary donations towards the cost of this, when booking, or in cash on the day.

Nativity roles have now been allocated to children and costume requests sent home, if required. Please send **named costumes** to school, in a **named bag**, by Wednesday 11th December. Thank you!

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Missing Children

Operation Endeavour is a safeguarding arrangement between Newcastle Children's Soc Care Service, Northumbria Police and schools and colleges in Newcastle to safeguard children and young people at risk of harm from going missing.

Children who go missing from home or care are at risk of serious harm and vulnerable to exploitation, including criminal exploitation and 'county lines', sexual exploitation, violent crime, gang exploitation.

Following any report of a child going missing to the Police, the Police will contact Children's Social Care who will then communicate relevant and necessary information to the child's school.
