<u>Communication and Language</u> You could try;

- retelling the stories of 'Handa's Surprise' and 'The Gruffalo' using puppets and props.
- answering how and why questions linked to the stories.

Mathematics

You could try;

- counting forwards and backwards to 20, saying what is one more or one less than a given number.
- reading and answering using simple addition and subtraction number sentences.
- Halving and sharing amounts into two equal groups.
- Recognising and using coins up to 20p.

Understanding the World

You could try;

- researching facts about Africa.
- thinking about how living in Africa would be different to living in the United Kingdom.
- finding similarities and differences between Africa and Britain.
- looking at a map to find Africa and the United Kingdom.

Expressive Arts and Design

You could try;

- listening to traditional African music and singing.
- looking at traditional African clothes and designing your own.

Characteristics of Effective Learning

You could be;

- finding out and exploring.
- willing to have a go.
- playing with what I know.
- being involved and concentrating.
- enjoying achieving.
- persistent and keep on trying.
