We would appreciate a comment in Reading Records whenever you listen to your child please.



This term we are asking children to complete Maths and SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar) homework too. Homework will be set. For Years 1-4, each Thursday and collected the following Tuesday. Please ensure children complete their written homework neatly and in pencil and return it to school please. As discussed at Welcome Meetings, we would be grateful if parents

would mark the work (using answer page at the back of the book) so that staff use a Tuesday evening to evaluate the success of the tasks and plan next steps for learning. Many thanks in advance for your support.
