


Dance Club has now moved to after school on Thursday as the Hall will be required for our new Breakfast Club. Yoga is now open to children in Years 1-4.

#### CAFÉ BEAM

The former Fire Station, on Gosforth High Street, is to be transformed into a new cafe as part of an exciting move by children's charity Smile For Life. "Cafe Beam" will provide a fabulous environment for young people with disabilities and learning difficulties to gain hands on work experience, learn new skills and meet many members of the community. In addition, it will be a great place to take children (individuals or groups) with additional needs and will feature a spacious café area, Autism friendly and braille menus.



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They also offer a room which can be used for private meetings, outside catering, parental support groups, access to equipment to enhance the lives of people with disabilities and a youth club for children aged 10+ each Tuesday evening 5:00pm-7:00pm.



Café Beam are looking for regular volunteers to support young people with learning difficulties as they complete their work experience placement. This role is extremely rewarding and varied and volunteers will acquire a real insight into the operational side of their organisation as well as gaining valuable experience in working with people with special educational needs.
