THANK YOU!

TEST & TRACE

We have been asked to remind parents only to seek a test if you or your child has symptoms of coronavirus. Please do not book tests for runny noses. Thank you.



ILLNESS

Scarlet fever has been reported in Reception class. Scarlet fever is a bacterial infection which causes a sore throat, high temperature, flushed face and red tongue. It is later followed by a rash which looks like sunburn. If you think your child may be infected, please contact your GP as soon as possible and they will most likely prescribe antibiotics. Your child must remain absent from school until they have been treated for at least 24 hours and are well enough to return to school. Thank you.

If you have received your activation email please activate your account and download the Tapestry App in order to receive notifications. This will only be used in the event of school or bubble closure or self-isolation.

PARENT/TEACHER CONSULTATIONS



If you have not done so already, please book your appointment via ParentMail by 4th October. Separated parents can book individual appointments -please inform Mrs Pygall so she can allocate you an additional appointment for your child on ParentMail.

Children on the SEND register will receive longer telephone appointments later on this term to review their Individual Education Plans (IEPs).

Families may, if they wish, book a Parents' Evening Consultation appointment but please note the limited time and the forthcoming IEP review.

BREAKFAST CLUB & AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

Next Thursday, 1st October, bookings for Breakfast Club and After School Club places in November can be made via ParentMail. Parents will need to add the days required to your basket on ParentMail **before 15th October**. This month, several parents have missed the deadline for booking meaning the



booking form has had to be re-opened and staff rotas have not been able to be finalised yet. This will not be able to be repeated in future.



Ad hoc bookings can be made, subject to availability, up to **a week in advance** by emailing admin. The cost will be added to your ParentMail account and payment must be received before your booking is final. Places available will be determined by ratios of organised staffing. **Please note that if either club is full, ad hoc bookings will not be possible.**

If you are paying with childcare vouchers, please only allocate the correct amount for the month.

	Work	Ask your boss about sick pay. If you need an isolation note visit: 111.nhs.uk/isolation-note.	
ł	Children	Contact the school to arrange for free school meals to be delivered home, and ask for school work.	
*	Dependents	Ask friends or family to provide care for dependents. If they can't help, call the council on 0191 277 8000	
8	Mental Health	Be mindful of your mental health. Create a routine, keep busy, stay active, and speak to friends. Ask for help if you need it.	
六	Physical Health	Think about how you can keep fit indoors. Change the dates of routine appointments.	
Ę	Medication	Contact your GP or pharmacy to arrange for your prescription to be delivered or ask someone to collect it for you.	
	Animals	Check you have enough pet food and supplies. If required, ask someone else to care for your animal(s) while you are isolating.
