CAROL SERVICE



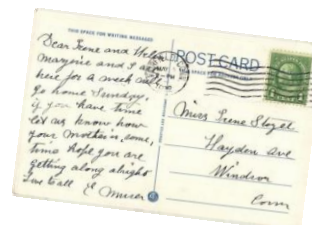
