SIAMS

As some of you will know, as a Church of England First School, ARFS is subject to a Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS), in addition to the usual Ofsted inspections. Our next inspection is likely to be in 2022.

SIAMS will judge the school on seven areas: Vision & Leadership; Wisdom, Knowledge & Skills; Character Development; Community and Living Well Together; Dignity & Respect; the impact of collective worship; and the effectiveness of religious education.



The staff, governors and children continue to prepare for this inspection through our day-to-day work. We will, in due course, seek to engage further with parents and carers and gather views around each of these areas. We would really welcome your thoughts and opinions in order to help us further improve our school distinctiveness and ethos.

SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL

This week, I have sadly been contacted by the NCC Road Safety Manager, Cheryl Ford Lyddon, to ask me to remind to parents and carers that they must stop for the School Crossing Patrol officer near our school when she signals for them to do so and when she is in the middle of the road. This rule applies to motorists **and cyclists**.

There has been a number of occasions where a parent on his bike has ridden through the School Crossing Patrol as she was stopping traffic and was assisting

pedestrians across the road. Please ensure that you are following the law for the safety of our school families and the wider community. Thank you.

PARKING AROUND SCHOOL

I have also, this week, once again been contacted by school families and local residents about parents and carers of our school parking on the double yellow and zig-zag lines outside school. We frequently request surveillance and support in enforcing parking restrictions. If you would



like to log your concerns directly, please contact Parking Services on 0191 261 4503 or via email at parking@newcastle.gov.uk. If a vehicle is causing an immediate obstruction to pedestrians or other road users or driving dangerously, please call Northumbria Police on 101.

If you wish to request enforcement action because a vehicle is parked in contravention of a parking restriction, please contact the Parking Enforcement Team with the details of the vehicle, i.e. vehicle registration number, make and model of the vehicle and the location where it is parked. They can be contacted on 0191 277 2739 between the hours of 6.30am to 9.30pm, Monday-Saturday and 8.00am to 5.30pm on Sunday.

In order to keep our children safe, please park and drive considerately around school. We understand that parking close to school can be very challenging but ASDA remain happy for our families to use their carpark and walk to school from there.

Our priority is the safety and wellbeing of our pupils and we would very much appreciate your continued support with this. Thank you.
