READING RECORDS

As you may have noticed, staff have once again begun recording in Reading Records each time they listen to children read. We would be grateful if parents could continue to use Reading Records to let staff know how children are managing their reading at home, what they found interesting or challenging and what their understanding of the text was like. There are helpful hints for the sorts of things that you can record in the front of each reading record if you are stuck! Parents of children in Reception and Year 1 can also include how children got on with their phonics activities in here too. Thank you!



TRANSITION

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Children in Reception will begin preparing for transition to Year 1 later this term. This will mean they begin to enter school via the main cloakroom door and have playtimes on the main yard. Miss Wilkinson will let Reception parents know when these changes will begin.



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Children who are due to begin Nursery or Reception at ARFS, in September 2021, and who are new to our school family will (hopefully!) soon be invited to attend small group welcome meetings with EYFS staff,

once restrictions allow. We will send further information once places have been accepted by all families.

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We are hopeful that Gosforth Central Middle School will soon let schools and families know of plans for Year 4 transition events. These will, ideally, be a combination of face-to-face and virtual activities. We have already begun to have key conversations with the school's Head of Year 5 and SENCo in preparation for next academic year.

Thank you to Year 2, who led our Palm Sunday worship and clergy from All Saints' who led worship on Maundy Thursday. Both were excellent events and it was lovely to come together as a whole school for these sessions.
