

NURSERY APPLICATION FORM – FOR JANUARY 2022 CLOSING DATE FRIDAY 22ND OCTOBER 2021

For children who are 3 years-old on or before 31st December 2021

Archbishop Runcie CE First School offers 15 free hours of childcare per week (which is offered as 2½ days) and 30 hours childcare which is offered as 5 days per week, during term time. Sight of birth certificate and proof of address will be required upon Application. You will need to provide sight of original documents to the school; your application and offer of a place is dependent on this.

Option 1 or Option 2 - 15 hours per week

In applying for and accepting a nursery place at Archbishop Runcie CE First School for 15 hours you are entering an agreement to use your initial 15 free hours with Archbishop Runcie CE for the entire academic year of 2021-22.

Option 3 - 30 hours per week

For those parents who are eligible for the 30 hours code: In applying for and accepting a nursery place at Archbishop Runcie CE First School for 30 hours, you are entering an agreement to use your initial 15 free hours and the additional 15 funded hours with Archbishop Runcie CE First School for the entire academic year of 2021-22. You also agree to confirm your 30 hours code by the deadline requested by Newcastle City Council or this will affect your child's additional free 15 hour place and you will be charged the cost of the remaining 15 hour nursery place.

NB: It is your responsibility to reconfirm your 30 hour code every 3 months on the Government portal.

<u>For those parents who are not eligible for the 30 hours code</u>: For those who wish to purchase the additional 15 hours the cost will be £15 per half day session.
