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

Our school target for attendance is 97%.

As you are aware, good attendance correlates with the strong academic progress of children in school. In order for us to improve overall attendance for our school, we need the support of both parents and children. We would be grateful if you could follow our guidance for parents please, which includes:



Red - Danger Zone - Below 90%

Amber - At Risk Zone - 91% - 96%

Green – Safety Zone – 97% - 100%

- Making sure your child goes to school and arrives on time (8:45am)
- Avoiding taking holidays in term time
- Arranging non-urgent medical and dental appointments for after school
- Ensuring children return to school as soon as possible following an illness

On Friday, we issued Attendance letters to all families so all parents should now be aware of their child's attendance traffic light "rating", at this point in the year. If your child is experiencing difficulties, which affect their attendance, please do not hesitate to contact their class teacher. Thank you very much with your support in this matter.


