# **WEBSITE**


Dates have now been added to the website calendar for this year. Autumn term dates are attached below but if you would like to see what's happening in Spring and Summer terms please visit our website.

In addition, we have now subscribed to "Rock Stars times tables" that children in Y2-4 can access from home- class teachers will share further information about this at Welcome Meetings.

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#### FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If you are in receipt of Child Tax Credit, with no Working Tax Credit (income below £16,190), Income Support, Income Based Jobseekers Allowance, Income Based Employment and Support Allowance, Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit or fall under the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 you may be entitled to qualify for free school meals. Just call 0845 6006400 to apply immediately over the phone, if you have not done so already. Alternatively you can log on to https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals

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Not only does this allow your child to have a free hot meal each day, it also brings funding (known as Pupil Premium) directly in to the school. If you qualify, you will also be entitled to a **10% discount off school uniform** prices. Please see Mrs McCloud for more information.

We would like to encourage all families to fill in the Free School Meals application form that is coming home today please (Nursery and Reception parents did this as part of their admission pack).

### BEAMISH VISIT/JEANS FOR GENES
