<u>Literacy</u>

You could try;

- listening to the story 'I am Amelia Earhart'.
- writing about where in the world you would like to visit.
- using phase 3 sounds in your writing.
- reading and spelling high frequency words correctly.

Mathematics

You could try;

- playing counting games with numbers to 20
- recognising, writing and ordering numbers to 20.
- adding more to a number or taking away from a number within 20.
- using natural objects to find double or half of an amount.

Understanding the World

You could try;

- investigating who Amelia Earhart is and write a fact book about her.
- making a large map and planning the route an aeroplane would need to take to get from the airport to a new place.

<u>Expressive Arts and Design</u>

You could try;

- making some junk model vehicles.
- making different types of planes to see how far they travel
- making a hot air balloon with a balloon and a paper cup.

You could try;

- finding out and exploring.
- willing to have a go.
- playing with what I know.
- being involved and concentrating.
- enjoying achieving.
- persistent and keep on trying.
