

English: English will be based around the story of Jack & the Beanstalk and other Jack/ giant/ fairy stories. We will initially be looking at fiction then we will move on to poetry and non-fiction reading and writing.

Art: Our focus in Art will be collage. We will be looking closely at pattern, size and colour.



Maths: We will be looking at measures in different contexts including problem solving e.g. measuring beanstalks. We will revisit work on addition and subtraction looking particularly at vocabulary for + and -. Year 2 will also be looking at using multiplication and division facts.

DT: We will research books with moving parts and then make our own based upon Jack and the Beanstalk.



RE: Our RE unit this term will be 'Jesus was special.' The aim of this unit is to: enjoy exploring these Bible stories that reveal Jesus' power and divine nature. Talk about how and why Jesus was special.

Key Stage One
Term 2a
Jack & the Beanstalk

PE: Initially we will be developing our basic skills; balance, agility and coordination. Before doing a "Jack and the Beanstalk dance" using the story, props and music as a stimulus for movement.

Computing: We will be producing a short video of ourselves making a healthy bean snack.

Citizenship: We will be looking at caring for living things. We will also be looking at moral issues, what is right and wrong linked to 'Jack and the Beanstalk' e.g. taking things that do not belong to you.

Science: We will be thinking about what beans need to grow, what the functions of the different parts of the bean plant are and carrying out some comparative tests.



History: The children have asked to learn about Castles; why they were built and when they were built.

Geography: We will be finding out where foods come from, where in the world these places are and finding out what they are like.
