This is an exciting opportunity to work as part of our supportive EYFS team to further advance our Nursery class. It will be an opportunity to play a full part in the continued development of our vision for all our children to become confident, secure, caring individuals who flourish through our ambitious and creative curriculum. The role is fixed term until the end of summer 2022.

This post is suitable for an experienced Teaching Assistant and/or someone with a good level of qualification. A willingness to cover Breakfast Club (from 7:45am) and/or After School Club (until 5:15pm), when needed, would be an advantage. This post is N4, 32.5 hours per week (term time only), 8:30am-3:30pm, 5 days per week. The postholder will be expected to be flexible and work additional hours to meet the needs of the school where required.

The successful candidate will set high standards for themselves, the school and our children. S/he will have a positive outlook and will be excited at the prospect of working as part of a small team where everyone "mucks in".
