We hope you all enjoyed a safe and restful summer break. A particularly warm welcome to our new children and their families - we are really looking forward to getting to know you!

The children have amazed us all this week by skipping into school and have settled really well into their new classes. Our new Reception children in particular deserve a huge thank you for their amazing manners and such a calm and settled start to their school career. Thank you all!

RETURN TO SCHOOL

The arrangements we set out at the end of term in July remain unchanged and school has, this week, begun to operate with a little more "normality". As mentioned in July, this includes the removal of isolated class bubbles – children (and staff) were delighted to find out about this!

Face coverings continue to be recommended for staff, visitors and parents/carers in areas where social distancing is not possible; therefore, staff and parents are asked to continue to wear face coverings at drop off and pick up times. Thank you!

Despite the removal of some of the most restrictive guidance mentioned above, schools still have a responsibility to have an appropriate health and safety risk assessment in place; therefore, some of the protective measures are to remain in place to minimise transmission of the virus in school.

- Measures we will continue to take are:
- \cdot Ensure good hygiene for everyone.
- \cdot Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
- \cdot Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- \cdot Follow Public Health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing
- confirmed cases of COVID-19.

We would be grateful if children with packed lunches continue to avoid bringing food containing nuts, fizzy drinks and confectionery in lunch boxes and please continue to cut grapes into halves to minimise the risk of choking. Natasha's Law 1 October 2021

I am sure you will have heard about the new legislation which is effective from 1 October 2021 called Natasha's Law; this relates to the labelling of food allergens for prepacked food at the point of sale. The School Meals Service are introducing new measures in order to ensure that they comply with the legislation. Some changes will be that food, previously prewrapped, will no longer be prewrapped. Packed lunches for school visits will contain prepacked sandwiches to ensure that all allergen information is available for children and staff. As always, chefs have all allergen information available in the kitchens; however, we would be grateful if you could please ensure that Mrs Pygall is informed of all new children with food allergies and current children's records are kept fully up to date.



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SUN SAFETY

Typically, we have had beautiful weather this week! Please ensure that, on sunny days, children have suncream applied before school. This should be the sun cream that lasts all day please. You may also like to send a **named** sun hat that can stay in school too. Thank you.

CHICKENPOX

We would like to alert you that chicken pox has been reported in school. If you have any concerns you can look at "The Little Orange Book" on our website.





BOOKBAGS

Each class has boxes for children to store their book bags in. Please could children all use school book bags rather than rucksacks? Children should not bring personal belongings to school in their bags or add bulky keyrings or toys to bookbags please. You may wish to write your child's name on the handle of the bag to help them identify it. Thank you!

HAND SANITISER

School provides all hand sanitiser for children as we must ensure that this complies with PHE guidance and is a minimum of 60% alcohol in order to be effective against coronavirus. Children do not need to bring their own to school. Many thanks.

READING & HOMEWORK

Reading books will be given out to children in Years 1- 4 this week. Please aim to listen to your child read aloud daily (it is still important to listen to children read; even when they are fluent and able, particularly in Years 3 and 4). You can use the question stems in the Reading Records if you are struggling to think of questions after reading. We would appreciate a comment in Reading Records whenever you listen to your child please. Thank you.



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Staff in Years 1 - 4 have carried out reading assessments this week and will carry out further reading assessments of children next week also to ensure books are well-matched to children's abilities. Children in Years 2 onwards are able to choose from a *range of challenge*. After children in Years 2- 4 have completed a book, they will be given a quiz to check their understanding. Any questioning that you have done at home will support them approach this.

Children in Years 1-4 are also given Maths and SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar) homework too, via IXL. Class Teachers will give details of homework expectations via Reading Records. Homework will be set each Thursday and should be completed by Tuesday of the following week please. Many thanks in advance for your support.

Usernames and passwords for online resources are kept in reading records for our Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4 children. Please ensure children bring these records into school each day. Thank you.

- Allocated places regardless of whether your child attends or not (e.g. absence due to illness) due to staffing and overtime arrangements
- Any arrears on payments will be referred to the Local Authority Debt Management Service and your child will no longer be eligible for a place

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
