What is Purple Mash?

Purple Mash is a comprehensive suite of online learning tools and content, designed to be used by Primary aged children in the classroom and at home. Every child in school has access to Purple Mash, a whole world of fun and exciting learning opportunities in one safe place. For Reception children, you will find their log in details at the back of their reading record.

What should you do first?

To begin with, it's a good idea to log in to Purple Mash with your child. Children in Reception have access to Mini Mash. This is the opportunity to learn through play and technology. Children can explore all areas of Mini Mash, making pictures, exploring sounds and practicing their phonics.

Each child also has their own area which they can save their work to. I am able to monitor this area and see the work your child has complete. Under the purple pin I have set up more specific areas of learning and activities for children to explore.
