READ WRITE INC

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In September, school adopted Read, Write Inc as our school phonics programme. Thank you for your patience as reading books for younger children arrived later than we had hoped.



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There are lots of ways you can support at home:



- Read with your child every day
- Going through the "Speed Sounds" books
- Reading green (phonetically plausible words that can be sounded out) and red words (that can't be sounded out)
- Asking questions (at the back of the book) after your child has read



During these discussions we will aim to teach our children the NSPCC's Underwear Rule, using the 'PANTS' acrostic (which is a bit like a green cross code for staying safe from sexual abuse).

PANTS stands for:

- Privates are private
- Always remember your body belongs to you
- No means no
- Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help.

It would be great if parents of children in Years 1 – 4 could also reinforce this rule at home. Thank you!

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
