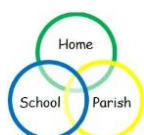
NURSERY

PERMISSION TO COLLECT CHILDREN

Please could all parents and carers make sure 'permission to collect' and data collection forms have been returned to school as soon as possible? READ WRITE INC

In September, school adopted Read, Write Inc as our school phonics programme. Thank you for your patience as reading books for younger children arrived later than we had hoped.



There are lots of ways you can support at home:



- Read with your child every day
- Going through the "Speed Sounds" books
- Reading green (phonetically plausible words that can be sounded out) and red words (that can't be sounded out)
- Asking questions (at the back of the book) after your child has read

- **T**alk about secrets that upset you
- **S**peak up, someone can help.
