

Autumn Term 2 2016 Nursery

Movement and handling

Children will continue to build up a range of movement skills in PE. We will be using the 'Sticky kids' cd as resource. In handwriting, we will use different activities and resources to work on our fine motor skills. This will help to develop our pencil pressure and grip. We will be teaching handwriting patterns and letter shapes.

Goldilocks and the three bears Nativity story

Literacy

We will be learning and retelling the traditional tale of Goldilocks and the three bears. The children will draw pictures from the story. The children will continue to develop their listening skills through Phase 1 in phonics. Nursery rhymes will continue to be a part of our everyday routine.

Mathematics

We will be learning about different size. We will talk about and make our own repeating patterns. Children will continue to recite numbers from 1-10 and start to recognise some numerals. Children will begin to represent numbers with their fingers and marks.

Exploring and using media and materials

We will be making the faces of either Goldilocks or the three bears using different materials. We will be learning about different materials and talk about different textures. The children will be making different Christmas decorations. We will be learning to use a range of tools. We will explore colour and how colours can be changed through our fireworks pictures.



Being imaginative

The children will enjoy weekly sessions with the Piccolo music group. We will be learning Christmas songs for our performance. The children will develop a range of roles within the Goldilocks and three bears story and be performing in our Christmas Nativity.

Understanding the world

Through our RE topic we will talk about ourselves, family and people that are special to us and special events in our lives. We will be using a cd player to listen to our Christmas songs.

Religious Education

We will continue our topic 'I am special'. At Christmas, we will talk about birthdays and how we celebrate Jesus' birthday. We will be retelling the story of the Nativity.
