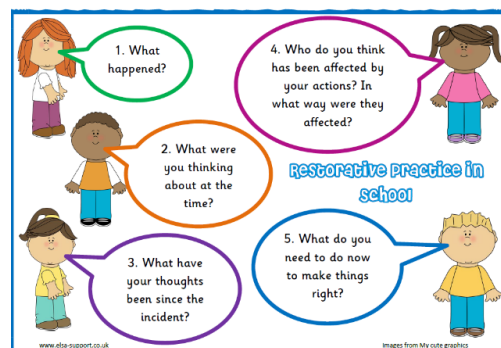
### PTFA

### BEHAVIOUR

Further to our work last academic year, this week all staff have attended training on dealing with behaviour using a restorative approach. Incentives and praise are used throughout school to reward and encourage positive behaviour. When incidents do occur, they will be dealt with using a restorative approach rather than a punitive approach. Staff will use the following open ended questions as a scaffold to encourage children to take ownership of their own behaviour and take responsibility for repairing damage or upset caused.

- Tell me what happened
- What were you thinking at the time?
- What are you thinking now?
- Who has been hurt/upset by your behaviour?
- What could you do to put things right?
- What would you do differently next time?



This approach has been proven to improve behaviour in many schools, similar to the approach of Restorative Justice used when dealing with crime, and supports our work on Growth Mindset whereby we can learn from our mistakes.

It would be really helpful if parents could use this at home too- let us know how you get on!

### BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL



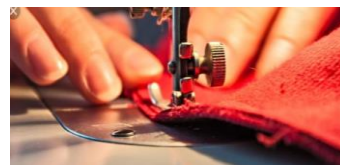

Miss Wilkinson and Mrs Francis have spent a lot of time over the summer ensuring the EYFS resources are well organised and we would like it to stay that way. Please could children not climb trees at this time either. Children are not allowed to do so during the day and we

would be grateful if parents could reinforce this rule after school too. Thank you in advance for your support.

### RECEPTION BASELINE PILOT

We have agreed to take part in the new DfE Reception Baseline pilot. The reception baseline assessment (RBA) is a new national assessment that will be administered in all primary, infant and first schools in England to pupils in reception classes. It will be introduced in Autumn 2020. The assessment will provide a snapshot of where pupils are when they arrive at school, establishing a new starting point to measure the progress they have made by the end of Year 6.

The RBA is a short (approximately 20 minutes), practical assessment focusing on their early literacy, communication, language and mathematics skills. A teacher or teaching assistant will carry out the assessment one-to-one with each pupil, any time in the first 6 weeks of reception. It does not require any preparation at home or at school, and will help teachers to understand what their pupils can do at the beginning of their time in reception.

The Standards and Testing Agency (STA) carries out trials and pilots as part of the assessment development process, to ensure that the assessment works as it should and to understand where they may need to make changes.

This year, the DfE are carrying out a largescale RBA pilot. This is a national, voluntary pilot taking place in primary schools across England in autumn 2019. Our school has signed up to participate. It is not a legal requirement for schools to participate in the pilot, and therefore not a legal requirement for each pupil to participate. If parents have any questions about this, or wish to discuss their child's participation further, it is important that they speak to Miss Wilkinson, in the first instance.

Findings from the pilot will inform our final version of the assessment for its statutory rollout in Autumn 2020. They will not be used to measure the school or pupils that have taken part. Each pupil's personal information is stored safely and securely, in line with data protection regulations. You can access the privacy notice for the RBA pilot on NFER's website.

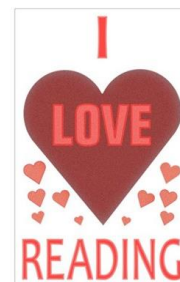
