Physical Education

In PE this term we will be building upon our dance skills. This will involve moving in different ways to different music and mirroring movements with partners.

Science

In Science we will be learning about different materials and their properties. We will explore and test the properties of a range of different materials and use this knowledge to suggest suitable materials for a shipmate's boots.

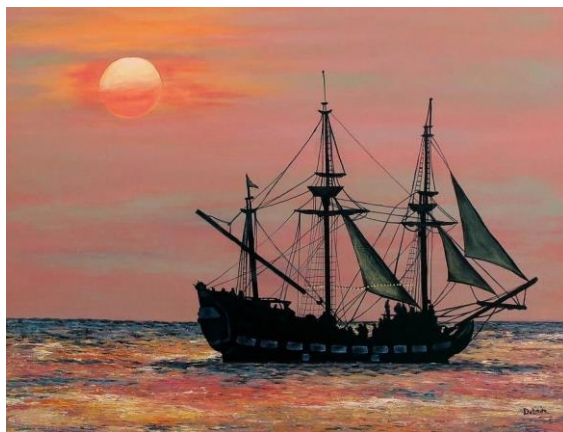


Religious Education

We will begin to explore the Christian idea of Salvation. This will involve looking at the Easter story and finding out why Easter is important to Christians.

English

In English we will be studying pirate texts, fiction and non-fiction as well as looking at Pirate poems. The children will identify key features such as rhymes. We will share their likes and dislikes as well as having the opportunity to perform a poem.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will be looking into drugs in the household. This will entail discussions based around household drugs and medicines we know and how we use them safely.

Art

We will practice the skill of colour mixing as well as identifying primary and secondary colours. We will then look at the work of Joseph Turner before creating our own seascapes.

Music

We will study a song the song 'Round Round' which is in a Bossa Nova Latin style. The children will share their opinions or a range of similar style songs before learning to play the sound using the glockenspiel.

Mathematics

We will be continuing to focus on place value (to 50), as well as exploring different types of measurements. This will include:

- Count in 2s and 5's
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least
- Measure and record length, height, weight and capacity.

Computing

In computing, we will be using an app called Book Creator on our Ipad to document our learning this half term. We aim to create an information book about Pirates.
